This doesn't need to be a complete CV, a statement such as "I completed my B.A. in Philosophy at Western University (2019), Master's of Public Health at the University of Toronto (2021) and have worked for two years as a policy analyst for PHAC focus on public health ethics" is sufficient.

Academic Writing Sample:

An academic writing sample is helpful for me to assess your academic preparation, clarity of communication, and critical thinking. Your academic writing sample can be anything you have written independently, such as a course paper, thesis, report. Please do not send co-written or professionally editing documents, such as journal articles.
